

Computer Science Minor Application-Request to Declare/Drop Minor

Are you interested in pursuing CS minor?

- In order to declare CS minor, students must successfully complete **ALL lower-division courses** required for the minor (outlined on next page).
- Courses completed for the CS minor must be completed with a **Letter Grade** (no S/NC).
- Students must be in **Good Academic Standing** to be eligible to declare a minor in CS.
- Students must declare a minor at least **2 quarters prior to graduation**.
- Please map out your remaining major and minor requirements using the course plan map provided. Please **highlight** all of the courses for the minor.
- Refer to the catalog to determine the **pre-requisites** for all minor-related courses and be sure to include them in your course plan.

Current BCOE Students

- Please work with the CS advisor to determine your **unit maximum** and make sure that you are able to satisfy both, major and minor requirements within the unit maximum. (Unit Maximums can be found at <http://student.engr.ucr.edu/policies/requirements/maxunits.html>)
- Once you have completed the course plan you may come in to discuss the possibilities of pursuing the CS minor with your assigned academic advisor.

Eligibility: Students majoring in the following majors are **NOT** eligible to declare a minor in CS.

- Computer Science
- Computer Science with Business Applications

- Receive Major Advisor's approval to pursue the CS minor
- Complete the CS Minor Application with all required signatures
- BCOE will process your application once we receive an email with the completed application via bcoeadvising@engr.ucr.edu
